## VISUAL SCHEDULE

A tool that provides children with a clear and organized representation of their daily routine. It often includes pictures, symbols or words that represent activities or transitions throughout the day in a sequential order.



## It will.

- Reduce anxiety
- Provide structure and a sense of safety
- Increase independence in daily routine
- Help create a predictable learning environment
- Help create a sense of belonging
- Promote engagement and participation

HERE are a few examples of visual schedules you can include in your classroom!

How to Implement a Visual Schedule:

- Create <u>Simple Visuals</u>

  Use pictures, icons or photos to represent each activity, with simple words
  - Involve the Children
    Introduce the schedule during
    circle time and review it together
    daily
  - Adapt

Include symbols for "Free Choice" or "Special Events" to prepare children for changes in their routine

 Place the schedule at eye level
 where all children can see it and
 refer to it throughout the day
